PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Applicant, Reid's Prospect PWC LLC, is seeking a proffer amendment for the portion of the Property that they own highlighted in yellow on the aerial on the next page. The proffers require these 12 subdivided units be live/work units. They will be removing the requirement that these units be live/work units. There is not a market for live/work units and due to the commercial being located further away from this site, the Applicant would like to have these units be strictly townhomes. The proposal will not have an impact on the approved level of service in Reid's Prospect because they were included as multifamily units for proffer payment purposes. The parcels are adjacent to the Hawthorne Retirement facility (see the aerial on the next page).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: On September 30th, at a Coles Supervisor Town Hall meeting, Mr. Jacobs presented a plan for a portion of the Independent Hill Small Area Plan (SAP). The Chairman typically is responsible for scheduling meeting locations, putting together the agenda for each meeting, maintaining the LOCCA web site (www.loccapeltva.org), and drafting letters (with the help of others) in response to projects reviewed at our meetings. It is anticipated that this position will need to be filled sometime in 2021 due to the relocation (out of state) of the current Chairman.
